

Report of the Strategic Director of People Services

Out of Authority Children Placed in Derby

SUMMARY

- 1.1 Derby Children and Young Peoples Department is required to maintain a register of children and young people placed in Derby by other authorities. As part of each local authorities duties they are required under the Arrangements for Placement of Children (General) Regulations 1991 (Regulation 10) to maintain a register of Children Looked After placed in its area, including those children who are the responsibility of another local authority.
- 1.2 Accurate and up-to-date information about children and young people placed in Derby by other authorities is important for planning purposes as well as taking into account for any resource implications and safeguarding issues. There is a requirement to share this information with the Virtual School Head and the Designated Nurse for Looked After Children to assist them in their planning, as well as share this information with DSCB so they can be assured these vulnerable children are safe.
- 1.3 The register is dynamic by nature and is expected to change on an on-going basis as children and young people move in and out of Derby. There are a total of 62 children placed in Derby at the time of writing the report
