







## Cumulative Impact Policy Consultation

We have been asked by Derbyshire Police to consider introducing a Cumulative Impact Policy (CIP). If implemented this will mean new applications for premises licences or club premises certificates, or variation applications for existing licences or certificates will be refused. The proposal is to include all premises located within the inner ring road.
