1.	Building Schools for the Future	Commission meeting 16 June 2009	To scrutinise the consideration of Carbon Emissions in the Building Schools for the Future scheme and make recommendations
2.	Engagement with Schools	Climate Change Board Meeting 23 June 2009	The Carbon Reduction Commitment will take into account the emissions of schools, even though they have no onus on the schools if emissions are not cut. It is not possible to pass financial penalties onto the schools if targets are not met. Commission may wish to undertake a review with schools (Governors/headteachers) to see what role they can play within the CRC and NI 186. Links to Climate Change Board strategy ST 3.
3.	Engaging the Population of Derby in Climate Change	Climate Change Board Meeting 23 June 2009	The national indicators linked to climate change require us to reduce per capita emissions. To do this, all people in Derby need to be engaged in the agenda – but how effectively are we getting the message across to a new audience? Commission may wish to undertake a survey with the public via a market researcher to get a fuller understanding of what the attitudes to Climate change are in Derby, and what people are willing to do to combat them Links to Climate Change Board strategy CL2

4.	Engaging Climate Change in everything we do	Commission Meeting 16 June 2009	<p>Focuses more on the internal ways we tackle climate change – are we as an organisation geared up to address climate change in everything we do? Look at AD champions (note that a competition is already planned for the Autumn)</p> <p>Look at what the other commissions are doing – do they consider carbon implications of the policies they scrutinise? Good example would be housing and Community Commission</p> <p>How do other authorities get Climate Change into all of their activities?</p> <p>Links to Climate Change Board Strategy CL 2</p>
5.	Street Lighting	Climate Change Board meeting 23 June 2009/Commission Meeting 31 March 2009	<p>To consider the ways in which street lighting can be used to reduce carbon emissions.</p> <p>Links to Climate Change Board Strategy OE 2</p>
6.	Renewable Energy	Climate Change Board meeting 23 June 2009/Meeting with Prof Tony Marmont 1 July 2009	<p>To select one area of renewable energy (for example solar/ hydro) and see if we are making the most of all opportunities that present themselves for incorporating them in what we do. Do we have, and are we providing, the right information on the possibilities for their use and the payback times?</p> <p>Links to Climate Change Board Strategy CL3,4,5</p>
