Urgent Non-Executive Decisions Made by the Chief Executive

RECOMMENDATION

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 In the Council's Constitution the Chief Executive has delegated authority to make decisions on behalf of the Council, in cases of urgency, in the discharge any non-executive function of the Council other than those delegated to another officer or those which by law can be discharged only by full Council.
- 2.2 This report advises Council of the following decision taken by the Chief Executive in accordance with his delegated authority:
- 2.3 Implications of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2006
 At their meeting on 7 March, Chief Officers approved in principle the resource proposals detailed in a report which summarised the implications of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2006. The report proposed the creation of five permanent staff posts within Property Services division to address the staff resource implications.
- 2.4 The funding was proposed to be taken from the corporate maintenance budget but since the total cost of the posts would result in a budget virement which exceeded £100,000, Financial Procedure Rules Appendix 2 virement point (b) required Full Council to approve the virement.
- 2.5 The leaders of the three political groups were consulted on the proposals and raised no objections.
