# The Subject Member's Right to Consult an Independent Person – Guidance Notes

# **SUMMARY**

- 1.1 At paragraph three of the Procedure for Considering Complaints That Members Have Breached the Code of Conduct, the subject members has a right to consult, through the MO, one of the Independent Persons (IP) appointed by the Council.
- 1.2 If a subject member exercises their right as above, it is proposed that the IP will read out guidance notes at their first meeting. The guidance notes set out what the subject member can expect from the IP.
