MOTION

(1) Congestion Charging – Approved as amended to read:

"Council notes that congestion charging would have an impact on the travelling public, visitors to the City and the economic well being of businesses in the City.

Council therefore calls on the Leader of the Council to:

- 1. reiterate his position that city residents should not be subject to a Congestion charge to drive on roads within the city boundary
- 2. work to ensure that a charging scheme will not be introduced in the City of Derby unless it is part of a wider scheme that provides first class public transport provision including a comprehensive transformation of park and ride facilities
- 3. demand that no charges are introduced until a first class public transport network and high quality park and ride facilities are in place on all the city's arterial roads

Council further resolves to call on the Council Cabinet to resist any political pressure from Government to impose a Congestion Charge unless all these conditions are met."
