107/05 Abolition of Home Care Charges

The Council Cabinet considered a report on the abolition of home care charges.

Options Considered

No other options have been considered.

Decisions

To recommend Council to agree to

- 1. Abolish Home Care charges from 1 October 2005.
- 2. Find savings equivalent to the net income losses of £913k as part of the 2006/07 budget process, above those already planned, and to fund the part year losses in 2005/06 from corporate under-spending.

Reasons

- 1. To make sure that vulnerable people in need are not deterred by the charges from accessing the service.
- 2. To enable a higher number of service users to receive this service, maximising their independence, enabling them to remain in their own home and reducing the need for residential care.
- 3. To eliminate the postcode lottery between Derby and Derbyshire residents who are already receiving a free service.
