Draft Performance Review Programme 2009/10

RECOMMENDATIONS

1.1 To consider the 2009/10 joint performance review programme, as shown in Appendix 2.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 There are currently three mechanisms in place to review performance across the Council and Partnership, which are....
 - Performance Support Group (PSG) this group is composed of Partnership and Overview and Scrutiny members to review Local Area Agreement indicators and other cross cutting National Indicators put forward by Derby City Partnership Management Group.
 - Overview and Scrutiny (O&S) Commissions to undertake thematic or detailed reviews and cover those underperforming indicators not picked up through the Performance Support Group.
 - Performance Surgeries are held as part of Cabinet member meetings to focus on Council-owned indicators (non-LAA) which are selected by either Chief Officer Group or Cabinet member themselves.
- 2.2 The permanent introduction of the Performance Support Group has provided the opportunity to develop a performance review programme for 2009/10 in conjunction with Overview and Scrutiny.
- 2.3 The joint review programme as shown in Appendix 2 will help to reduce the likelihood of the same areas being reviewed by the different groups. It will also maximise the use of resources in undertaking review work and add value to existing performance improvement activity.
- 2.4 To further minimise the likelihood of duplication in the areas reviewed, consideration has been given to the different review roles the PSG and O&S would undertake. Briefly, it is proposed that O&S would undertake broader and more in-depth reviews rather than focusing on the

- performance of an individual performance indicator which would be done by the PSG.
- 2.5 The two groups outlined above will also be supported by Cabinet Member Performance Surgeries, which will look to review indicators that the Council is solely responsible for and which sit outside of the LAA. Reviews to be covered through the format of Cabinet Member Performance Surgeries are also listed in Appendix 2.
- 2.6 As a work programme for 2009/10 has been developed and any further reviews areas will be highlighted in year through performance monitoring to Council and Partnership, the need for Scrutiny Commissions to review all indicators performance on a quarterly basis will be significantly reduced. It is therefore proposed that the Commissions review the work programme at each meeting to ascertain whether any further areas not previously identified as underperforming have been added to the work programme.
