PETITION – REPAIR TO DAMAGED TILED KERBS IN CHARTERHOUSE CLOSE, BREADSALL HILLTOP

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 A petition was received in November 2006 signed by 10 residents from Charterhouse Close requesting action to be taken to repair damaged tiled kerbs.
- 1.2 It is accepted that works are required to replace the existing kerb units that residents have highlighted. The blocks have suffered extensive frost damage and require replacing with concrete kerbing.
- 1.3 A scheme to replace the kerbs with concrete kerbing has been included in a list of potential highway maintenance schemes for the financial year 2007/08. The list of schemes was considered and approved by Council Cabinet on 20 February 2007. It is therefore envisaged that the work will be carried out during summer 2007.
- 1.4 A separate report appears elsewhere on the Area Panel agenda, which outlines the Cabinet approved work programme for 2007/08.

PROPOSED ACTION

- 2.1 The Area Panel is requested to note that the kerbing work on Charterhouse Close was included in the list of potential highway maintenance schemes for 2007/08. This preparation pool has now been approved by Council Cabinet and it is envisaged that work will be carried out during summer 2007.
- 2.2 The lead petitioner will be notified of the proposed action.
