TAXI LICENSING AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES 2011/12 QUARTER 1 AND 2

OTHER ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

5 x joint exercises with traffic police:

- 121 vehicles stopped
- 27 ok
- 48 advice
- 8 further inspection
- 38 suspended; 28 prohibited by police, 4 summonsed by fixed penalty or court

Plying for hire exercises:

- 2 pre-planned exercises; 5 drivers caught; 4 files to legal services for consideration; one warned following legal advice; represents approximately 13% of drivers approached
- 65 drivers of private cars moved on from taxi ranks
- 60 private hire drivers spoken to about being in a prominent position; 50% able to evidence legitimate booking; 25% verbal advice; 25% written warning
- 6 private hire vehicles licensed by other LA's warned re: no evidence of booking; details passed to relevant LA for action
- Complaint from hackney driver; warning letter sent to all identified drivers; approximately 70% able to evidence legitimate booking; further information used for intelligence
- 1 enforcement exercise by officers; 6 written warnings; 1 waiting for further advice from legal services
- Intelligence from response service about potential plying for hire confirmed legitimate booking
