Community budget 2015-2016

The ward Committee agreed the following spend;

- St Edmunds with St Osmonds Church £650 approved
- S.OL.I.D –£900 Approved
- Wilmorton Allotment Association £1,600 Approved
- Clearance of Alleyway Dickinson Street- £400 Approved landlords to be written to.

- Parameter Mound on Elvaston Lane Park £1,850 Approved.
- Hedge Maintenance on Alvaston Park £200 Approved
- Neighbourhood Officer budget £500 requested £1000 Approved- to include Crime Prevention Material.
- Replacement bollard Booth Street up to £500 approved

Streetpride devolved Budget 2015-2016

There was an underspend of approximately £2,600 due to a reduction in costs on slurry sealing. The ward committee agreed to reallocate this to:

- Link Footpath Wilkins Drive to Aldi Store at £2,400
- £30 towards speed volume survey (£220 already approved previously) on Radford Street.

Section 106 funding

The Ward committee agreed the following proposals for spend;

Former roundhouse allocation:

£11,784 - Use this towards 3 K-barrier on Alvaston park, after consultation with Alvaston Park friends and other user groups.

The ward committee does not want the AscD1-01 and Belw3-02 to be used on the 'Creative Pathway' project- they want it to be spent as proposed by the Board initially.
