Best Value Review of Development – Final Report and Improvement Plan

RECOMMENDATION

- 1.1 To approve in principle the Final Report and Improvement Plan of the Best Value Review Team.
- 1.2 To refer the report to the Planning and Environment Commission for comment.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

2. The improvements outlined in the Improvement Plan will help in delivering improved services and outcomes associated with applications for planning permission and Building Regulations approval. They will also assist in the better monitoring of development.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 3.1 As part of the 2003/2006 programme of Best Value Reviews, the Council has completed a review of the Development Service.
- 3.2 The review covered the work carried out by the Building Consultancy and Development Control sections, which form part of the Development Division of the Development and Cultural Services Department.
- 3.3 The Review Team, after engagement with stakeholders who have an interest and involvement in the Development Service, has identified a schedule of improvements outlined in the Improvement Plan at the end of the Final Report. The Final Report and Improvement Plan are attached at Appendix A.

- 4. The Options Appraisal process resulted in the following options not being taken forward...
 - revision and development of customer charters outlining levels of service

- training and support for frontline staff to develop greater specialist knowledge
- direct service control by the development service of the IT system that supports the service.
