# **REPLACEMENT CARPETS AT MARKEATON CREMATORIUM**

### RECOMMENDATION

1. To replace the carpets at Markeaton Crematorium at an estimated cost of £60,000 to be financed by prudential borrowing and an increase of £5 in the price of a cremation above the inflationary increase from April 2007.

### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 The carpets in the chapels at the crematorium have been in place for over 20 years and are in need of replacement.
- 2.2 There is no provision in the budget to replace the carpets and it is proposed that it is financed by prudential borrowing. To repay this money, the cost of a cremation will increase by £5 above the planned inflationary increase from April 2007.
- 2.3 The carpets are expected to last 20 years and will not be at risk when the mercury abatement work and replacement of the cremators take place.
