PEST CONTROL FEES & CHARGES

RECOMMENDATION

1. To approve the proposed fees and charges for providing the Council's pest control service.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Council's Pest Control team provides a service for the treatment of rodents, insects and other pests in domestic and commercial premises.
- 2.2 Treatment for rats in all domestic premises is provided free of charge. Treatments for all other pest species are provided at a reduced cost if the customer is in receipt of a low income benefit or is over 60 and not in full-time employment.
- 2.3 Commercial treatments are provided at commercial rates for businesses in Derby and surrounding areas.
- 2.4 Although the fees and charges have risen in line with inflation, they have not been reviewed for sometime. The review exercise examined the costs of the materials used and the other resources required to carry out the work. It also compared costs with other local authority pest control services and commercial operations.
- 2.5 The proposed fees and charges for 2008/09 are set out at Appendix 2. The current fees and charges have also been included for information.
- 2.6 The proposed fees and charges are much more comparable with other local authority pest control services and still lower than private company's commercial rates.
- 2.7 In an effort to increase commercial income, we will be undertaking a marketing drive over the next three months.
