Revenue Budget Proposals 2011/12 – 2013/14

SUMMARY

1.1 The Safer Communities Commission has the responsibility for scrutinising community safety issues and has been appointed as the statutory crime and disorder committee for Derby City. The Commission decided at its 18 January meeting to hold a special meeting on 31 January to consider the Councils budget proposals together with that of the Police Authority and Fire and Rescue Services on areas within its area of responsibility.

RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To consider and comment on Revenue Budget Proposals 2011/12 – 1013/14 affecting community safety issues in the city.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION
