Report summarising the new Anti Social Behaviour, Crime & Police Act 2014

SUMMARY

1.1 This report seeks to summarise and highlight to the Board the ethos behind the Antisocial Behaviour (ASB), Crime and Police Act 2014 and the new tools and powers available to statutory bodies including Derby City Council.

3.1 The Act allows for the adoption of new tools & powers by relevant bodies to support victims of ASB by broadening potential responses to complaints of ASB.
