## **Emergency Planning Report and 2007/8 Work Programme**

#### RECOMMENDATION

1. That the Scrutiny Management Commission note and approve the report and the work programme.

#### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 At its meeting in September 2006 the Scrutiny Management Commission resolved that it would in future request bi-annual reports on the Council's Emergency Planning activities and work programme. This report is the first of those bi-annual reports.
- 2.2 Local, regional and national exercises were held in February 2007 to test the arrangements for agencies dealing with a flu pandemic. Issues raised and lessons learnt from the City exercise will be included in a future review of the Council's Business Continuity Plan. Further work has been undertaken on personnel policies and procedures to take account of a potential flu pandemic.
- 2.3 Awareness training was held for Service Area Liaison Officers in April 2007 to highlight good practice and to inform officers of current work being undertaken to meet the duties of the Civil Contingencies Act 2004.
- 2.4 An out of hours communications exercise was held in March 2007 to test the City Emergency Plan.
- 2.5 The 2007/8 Work Programme for Emergency Planning has been prepared to meet the requirements of the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 and is as set out in Appendix 2.
