# Pathways Out Programme

#### SUMMARY

1.1 The Pathways Out Programme has developed an innovative approach of profiling some of the most at risk gang members in order to identify potential intervention measures that could be taken to combat gang and youth violence. This report profiles at twelve of the most at risk gang members in the city and looks at a wide range of indicators.

# RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To comment on the Pathways Out Programme in addressing criminal gangs activity and consider how it could be used tackle broader crime and anti-social behaviour problems in the city.
