- Door wind check straps weak operation
- Misaligned doors
- Water ingress into passenger/luggage compartment
- Unable to access engine/boot compartments
- Loose/deteriorated engine drive belts
- Battery insecure
- Illuminated warning lights on instrument panel
- Dirty interior/exterior
- First aid kits missing/unserviceable condition

- Fire extinguisher missing/unserviceable condition
- •Radiator coolant leak(s)
- •Engine oil leak
- •Exhaust system blowing/leaking
- Engine fuel leak(s)

^{*}Other refers to any defect outside the items listed in the "5 point safety check" (lights, brakes, tyres, steering & suspension) carried out by the testing stations during a spot check which can render a vehicle, if not always unsafe, certainly unfit for public service and/or in serious breach of licence conditions.

- Worn/defective seat belts

- •Defective windscreen wipers/washers
- •Loose/missing bodywork
