Arboretum Street area	Residents of Arboretum Street submitted a petition requesting resident only parking. Observations revealed that there is some commuter parking which may be generated by staff and visitors to the DRI. Royal Crown Derby have also complained about parked vehicles obstructing their access. An officer lead group is currently examining issues in and around the Arboretum. This scheme, if taken forward may well link with and enhance other initiatives in the area	High
Kings Mead Close	Residents of Kings Mead Close have contacted their Local Members as they feel that they are being precluded from parking at the roadside by commuters, students, etc. Further more detailed investigation is required into the situation here.	Medium
Chestnut Avenue, Normanton	A resident of Chestnut Avenue has requested a residents only parking restriction for Chestnut Avenue. In December 1999 residents of Chestnut Avenue, Lyndhurst Street and Cummings Street were surveyed and asked if they would like a residents only parking scheme. The response at that time was poor and the majority of respondents did not support a scheme.	Low
Chester Green area	Residents have reported concerns that they are unable to park near to their homes. Investigations undertaken in response to similar concerns in July 1999 revealed that the problem was that households had more than one car and that there wasn't enough parking to accommodate the needs of residents.	Low
Dale Road, Normanton	A resident has requested resident only parking because parking problems are created by visitors to a nearby religious establishment.	Low
Regent Street	Regent Street is a short street off London Road near to the DRI. The residents of Magee Court petitioned the Council expressing concern about the lack of [parking provision in their area. Investigations were made into the request. There are 26 flats within the Magee Court complex. A resident only parking scheme on Regent Street would only create 3 parking spaces for residents	Low
Portland Street	Cllr Hussain raised concerns about parking problems on this street at a meeting of Area Panel 3 and asked that resident only parking be considered.	Low
