Anti Social Behaviour in Normanton Topic Review Update

SUMMARY

- 1.1 At its first meeting of the municipal year, the Neighbourhoods Board agreed to consider how anti-social behaviour in the Normanton area could be tackled and see what lessons could be learnt for other parts of the City. This report outlines progress made and future timescales for the review.
- 1.2 At the September meeting of the Neighbourhoods Board, members agreed the scope and timescales for the Anti Social Behaviour in Normanton topic review.
- 1.3 The scoping report for this review identified that stage one of the review would involve the development of a 'problem profile' of the review area through the collation of data from various sources and partner organisations.
- 1.4 The purpose of this report is to enable the presentation of this 'problem profile' to board members, and to allow for a discussion to take place on how members wish to proceed into stage two of the review, and identify what further evidence is needed and agree future actions for the review.
