Outturn Report: Area Panel 1 Budget 2004/5

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 In 2004/5, Area Panel 1 was allocated a budget of £29,000. The panel also had an additional budget of £2,118 carried forward from 2003/4, making a total budget of £31,118 available to allocate to projects during 2004/5. The panel allocated £28,227 giving a carry forward budget of £2,891 to allocate to projects in 2005/6.
