

## **Devolution Deal – Draft Proposal for an East Midlands Combined County Authority**

### **Purpose**

- 1.1 At its meeting on 13 September 2022, Executive Scrutiny Board resolved to agree that a report on the Combined Authority proposals be brought at the earliest opportunity to a future meeting of the board.

### **Recommendation**

- 2.1 To consider the draft Proposal to create an East Midlands Combined County Authority (EMCCA) for the areas of Derbyshire County, Derby City, Nottinghamshire County and Nottingham City, as shown at Appendix 1.

### **Reason**

- 3.1 In order to progress the area's devolution deal, under the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill, a consultation is required on the draft East Midlands Combined County Authority (EMCCA) Proposal.
