Urgent Key Decision

16/19 Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG) Rough Sleepers Initiative Grant Application 2020/21

The Leader of the Council considered an urgent report of the Strategic Director of Communities and Place which sought approval to submit a bid to the MHCLG Rough Sleepers Initiative Grant 2020/21.

Decision

 To delegate approval to the Strategic Director of Communities and Place following consultation with the Director of Finance and Cabinet Member for Adults, Health and Housing to submit a Rough Sleeper Initiative (RSI) bid to the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG), for revenue funding up to a maximum of £730,000 and capital funding to a maximum of £55,000.

- 2. If Derby City Council is successful in the bidding process:
 - To delegate approval of the acceptance of any resultant MHCLG revenue and capital RSI grants to the Strategic Director of Communities and Place, following consultation with the Director of Finance and Cabinet Member for Adults, Health and Housing, subject to acceptable grant conditions.
 - To approve the transfer of any resultant RSI grants received, from Derby City Council to Derby Homes.
 - To add up to £55,000 capital funding to the corporate capital programme, funded by grants from MHCLG.
- 3. To authorise Derby Homes under Teckal principles to identify and process approve all necessary grant payments to third parties in relation to the project, subject to the approval of the Strategic Director of Communities and Place.
