PROPOSED INCREASE IN HACKNEY CARRIAGE TARIFF

RECOMMENDATION

- 1.1 To consider the proposed tariffs submitted and any objections received.
- 1.2 To approve one of the proposals submitted, or
- 1.3 To defer the matter until all parties agree on a single proposal.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 Licensing officers have recently received requests from hackney carriage trade representatives to consider an increase in the hackney carriage tariff, on the basis that it is now over two years since the last tariff increase and the costs of operating hackney carriages continue to rise.
- 2.2 It has been the practice in the past for the whole of the hackney trade to agree a particular revised tariff and for this tariff to be presented to this Committee for consideration by Members.
- 2.3 However, on this occasion, the two hackney trade associations DATOA (Derby Area Taxi Operator's Association) and DHU (Derby Hackney Union) have been unable to agree upon a mutually acceptable solution and each has submitted their own proposals.
- 2.4 Another trade representative (from Derby Cabs, a company operating around 30% of the Council's licensed hackney carriages) has formally requested that members should note their opposition to any increase in the hackney carriage tariff at present.
- 2.5 The proposals and objection are listed at Appendix 2.
