# "Superfast Broadband" January Project Update

#### **SUMMARY**

- 1.1 The Corporate Scrutiny and Climate Change Board have requested an update on the developments surrounding "superfast broadband" in the city.

The Voucher Scheme "soft launched" to coincide with "small business Saturday" in December. The "full launch" will take place on 20th January followed by, on 28th January, a "meet the supplier" event at Friar Gate Studios.

A mail-shot, announcing the availability of the Scheme will be sent to 11 thousand SMEs in Derby on Monday 13th January.

#### 4.2 Public WiFi

Installation works are progressing well and the scheme has now begun the second

phase of testing.

• The scheme will launch publicly on 15th February, with launch activities being coordinated with Jonathan Wallis of Derby Museum.

# 4.3 Demonstrator and co-working space at Friar Gate Studios

Installation works are complete, and the facility formally opens to the public on 20th January.

Initial feedback has been exceptionally positive, and the space is already 50% occupied.
