06/06 Taxi Licensing Section – Statistics for Licensing and Enforcement Activities – Quarters 1 and 2 2006

The Committee considered a report from the Director of Corporate and Adult Social Services that gave detailed of statistics for January to March and April to June 2006 of performance and workload data relating to taxi licensing activities. It was highlighted that, although a number of the figures for suspension of licences seemed high, they were a percentage from a 'targeted group' and did not reflect the whole of the taxi trade in general. It was noted that it was acknowledged by the trade that Derby City Council had high standards and expectations from its licensed vehicles.
