

Appointments to Derby City Charity

SUMMARY

- 1.1 Derby City Charity makes grants to people in need for essential items. Its constitution states that it will meet to consider applications at least twice per year.
- 1.2 There are currently five appointments – Councillors Raju, Repton and Webb, as well as former councillors Mr Ray Baxter and Mr Finbar Richards.
- 1.3 The terms of office of Councillor Repton and Mr Richards expire on 2 October 2015, so new appointees are now sought.

RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To consider and make appointments in respect of the vacancies that will arise on Derby City Charity on 2 October 2015.
- 2.2 To agree that any appointments will be until 20 May 2019, rather than for the usual four-year term, in order to bring them in line with the Annual Meeting cycle of other appointments to outside bodies.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 To ensure the range of knowledge and experience on Derby City Charity is not reduced as a result of vacancies.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 Council can appoint replacement members or reappoint existing members as it wishes.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED

- 5.1 Leaving the positions vacant reduces the pool of knowledge and experience that considers applications to the charity.
