## Cycling improvements - Mansfield Road, Chester Green Road

#### **SUMMARY**

- 1.1 Route 66 of the National Cycle Network passes through Chester Green. This area is well used by cyclists and has been identified as an area that could be improved. It is proposed to develop the cycling facilities on Mansfield Road, Chester Green Road and Stores Road.
- 1.2 The scheme aims to improve the safety of cyclists, make cycling more attractive to a wider range of cyclists, and improve access to the city centre.
- 1.3 Some footway improvements and a cycle dropped kerb are proposed to be carried out, adjacent to Mansfield Road opposite Caesar Street along with a dropped kerb on Chester Green Road to enable cyclists to cycle between Chester Green Road and Caesar Street more safely.
- 1.4 These proposals will improve a small area of Chester Green Recreation Ground and formalize a route presently used by cyclists.
