Council Cabinet 28 October 2008

130/08 Gayton Swimming Pool

The Council Cabinet considered a report on Gayton Swimming Pool and the comments of the Scrutiny Management Commission. The Court judgement required the Council to carry out such works as to put and keep the Gayton Pool and changing rooms in good repair and to reach agreement with the Community Association by 18 October 2008 to avoid the need for the Court to appoint an 'expert' to determine the works necessary. Further detailed work on possible options had now been carried out and the best option was to replace the whole of the building and changing rooms with a new building detached from the Community Centre. The estimated cost of this proposal was in the region of £1 million.

Options Considered

There were no options considered.

Decision

To approve the replacement of Gayton Pool with a new facility at an estimated cost of £1 million as described in paragraph 3.5 of the report.
