04/05 Review in Mobile Library Service and Reinvestment in Bookstart

The Cabinet Member considered a report from the Corporate Director for Leisure and Cultural Services regarding the review of the Mobile Library service and reinvestment in Bookstart. The mainstreaming of Bookstart had produced a budget pressure in 2006/7, but this coincided with the result of a review of the Mobile Library service, which promised some savings.
