1	alleyway gating		1,000	<b>Confirmed decision</b> Needs to link to bins off streets
2	clearance of alleyways		1,000	<b>Confirmed decision</b> Needs to link to bins off streets
3	Painting of street furniture	Bollards on Middleton Street to Hastings Street	1,000	<b>Confirmed priority</b> To form part of the Normanton in Bloom initiative.
4	Additional litter bin	By seat near Discount 2000 store on Cavendish On Dale Road, near temple; outside the health centre on St Thomas Road	1,278	<b>Confirmed priority</b> Three locations have been identified for additional litter bins. The one on S Thomas road will need to also have a cigarette stub box.
5	Installation of a bus shelter	Stanhope Street	3,800	<b>Confirmed priority</b> The Board is funding the bus shelter heading away from the city centre in 2012/13. The Streetpride devolved budget to fund the other direction (towards the city centre) in 2013/14 budget.
6	Improvements to parks and open spaces	Caxton Recreation ground – maintenance of football pitch and gal posts and benches and planting improvements	3000	<b>Confirmed priority</b> – needs to link with potential youth activity at the site and link to work of the Gangs Advisory Group
7	Normanton in Bloom	bulbs, street competition prizes, hanging baskets	2,000	<b>Confirmed priority</b> The Board were keen to split the funding across the three forum areas: Austin; Peartree and New Normanton. The aim will be to have a range of hanging baskets if possible in key areas and planters. They would like to see the active involvement of local schools and businesses in the projects including competitions. To support the project, they will be looking to partners to contribute to the project; for example Metropolitan; Derby Homes; Police; etc.
8	Take pride in your street	x 3 streets in Normanton Ward	3,000	<b>Confirmed priority</b> The Board would like to fund an initiative in three streets. Therefore, there has been an increase in the budget. The Board would like to have more involvement in the organisation of the days and suggested changes such as door knocking the day before the initiative.
9	Contribution to Clarence Road/Porter Road scheme	Implementation of proposed one way scheme	10,200	<b>Confirmed priority</b> – awaiting outcome of consultation with local residents.
