# Outbreak Engagement Board and Health Protection Board Update

# **Purpose**

1.1 To provide the Health and Wellbeing Board with an update and overview of the key discussions and messages from the COVID Outbreak Engagement Board and Derbyshire Health Protection Board.

#### Reason

3.1 To ensure the Health and Wellbeing Board is kept updated on health protection issues affecting the population of Derby.

## **Supporting information**

- 4.1 The Derby Outbreak Engagement Board continues to meet routinely, albeit less frequently, to discuss and respond to emergent issues. Further meetings are called as necessary to respond to urgent issues.
- 4.2 The Derby Outbreak Engagement Board oversees the preparation and publication of the Local Outbreak Management Plan.
- 4.3 The Board routinely reviews and discusses the following standing items:
  - Protection: providing an overview of latest COVID data reporting updating on current COVID cases and rates across the city and any local outbreaks. Additionally, updates are provided on local community testing.
  - Treatment: providing an update on the local Health and Care System including situational update and any existing or emergent pressures.
  - **Prevention:** providing an update on progress and plans of the local vaccination programme.
- 4.4 The local position in relation to contact tracing, community testing, vaccination programme, communications and support of the Clinically Extremely Vulnerable along with any emerging issues are also discussed as required.

- 4.5 The standard Health Protection Board met again on the 9th March and are reviewing their Terms of Reference and priorities for the coming year
- 4.6 As we move to the next phase of COVID the COVID Health Protection Board are reviewing their functions.
- 4.7 Given the constantly changing picture, the Director of Public Health will report at the meeting to provide the Health and Wellbeing Board with as current a picture as possible.

#### Public/stakeholder engagement

5.1 As part of the local outbreak planning arrangements, the Derby COVID Outbreak Engagement Board was established. A key function of this group is to engage with the local community to understand any local issues and communicate effectively with local people.
