01/18 Appointment of Chair

## 06/18 Minutes of the Meeting Held on 19 March 2018 and Matters Arising

## 07/18 SACRE Membership, Resignations and Vacancies

There were no resignations to report and the Democratic Services Officer asked Members for recommendations for any potential nominations to fill the current vacancies.

## 08/18 Derby Prevent Plan Update

The Head of Service, Partnerships and Communities presented a verbal report which updated SACRE on the Derby Prevent Plan.

The SACRE heard that the Derby Prevent Plan was a part of a national strategy which contained four key elements:

- Pursue
- Prepare
- Protect

- Prevent

Regionally there were three further key elements:

- Responding to extremism
- Prevent vulnerable people being drawn in
- Working with organisations.

Members were also informed that there were two new posts within the Community Safety Team; a Support Officer and a Prevent Education Officer to which officers had been appointed to.

SACRE Members discussed the role of Religious Education in the Prevent agenda, they were assured by the Head of Service, Partnerships and Communities this was part of the remit to be addressed by the Prevent Education Officer.

## 09/18      Revision of the Agreed Syllabus

The Lead Officer for SACRE led the discussion on the Revision of the Agreed Syllabus. SACRE Members were informed that they have a statutory responsibility to revise the Religious Education syllabus the one which was currently being used was RE Today by Lat Blaylock.

Members discussed the matter at length, the issues surrounding revision of the Religious Education Syllabus and the various options available.

The SACRE Lead Officer informed Members Lat Blaylock had suggested a joint SACRE meeting with nominated members from each SACRE attending

## 10/18      Update – The Open Centre

Sam Mitchell The Open Centre Manager gave the Members a verbal update of the work The Open Centre had undertaken. The update included the following information:

### **School linking Programme – The Open Centre and Global Education Derby**

The Schools Linking Programme in Derby aims to bring communities together by linking schools from across the City. Two classes from two demographically diverse primary schools were brought together creating year-long curriculum rich class links for pupils in Key Stage 2. School Linking had been endorsed by the Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) and the Department for Education (DfE).

#### **The Linking Year**

The SACRE Members heard that the children will meet three times in the year, usually the first of these meetings was at a neutral venue followed by visits to each school in the spring / summer term. They exchange work throughout the year and through this structured programme explore four key questions:

- Who am I? – exploring identity
- Who are we? – celebrating diversity
- Where do we live? – promoting community
- How do we all live together? – championing equality

We have had 14 classes from 9 schools on the programme including faith schools (437 children)

#### **Issues**

Parental refusal/school cancellations – more of a Derbyshire issue

The Open Centre was currently trying to tackle this issue with pre-visits, talks with parents, advice sheets for teachers/headteachers along with email and telephone conversations.

This was through some additional funding from the Home Office/Global Education (Building stronger Britain Together – BSBT Fund)

### **11/18 Update – The Christianity Project**

SACRE members received a verbal report from Alison Brown the SACRE Church of England representative which updated them on the – Understanding Christianity Project. Alison Brown reported that An Evaluation of Understanding Christianity Questionnaire had been circulated to schools but it was mainly Church schools which had responded. On the reverse side of the sheet which was circulated at the meeting were samples of the feedback the evaluation had generated.
