| 3 | Police Report There have been a number of issues recently within the Chaddesden ward. Insp. Keene gave an overview of the areas of concern and the actions that are being taken to address them. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Problems on Chaddesden Park with youths. Complaints have been received from Cherry Tree Hill Junior school. A PCSO was also assaulted. Offenders have been arrested Issues at Chesapeake and problems at Roosevelt Ave with anti social behaviour. Resources have been allocated to tackle the ASB and figures have started to decrease. Sgt Adams has asked officers to attend Chesapeake on a regular basis. The recycling bins will be removed in the near future and the | |

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| | <p>Neighbourhood Team and partner agencies are looking at making the area less attractive to the youths.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Speeding on Reginald Rd South. Six officers at Roe Farm will be trained to use speed guns. Training will take place mid November. Speeding hot spot areas are Reginald Rd South, Oregon Way, Max Road. • There have been a number of burglaries in the Chaddesden area. Operation Synchronize has been introduced to tackle the problem and a number of arrests have been made. • Chaddesden library has been target hardened • Sgt Bonsor will be replacing Sgt Meakin on 5th November. • Crime has fallen by 12% in Chaddesden compared to last year. • Test purchases were carried out in the Chaddesden ward earlier in the year. A number of pubs and off licences failed. As a result they were issued with fixed penalty notices • An alcohol free zone or dispersal order for Chaddesden has been suggested. The Neighbourhood Team and partner agencies will give the matter some consideration. • Shed alarms are being supplied to victims and vulnerable people. | <p>Police to liaise with Highways re speed checks</p> |
| 4 | <p>Highways and Transport Programme 09/10</p> <p>Christine Durrant, Assistant Director, Highways and Transport delivered a report on the information which was circulated with the meeting paperwork to establish the 3 key priorities for the Chaddesden Ward Neighbourhood Board.</p> <p>Chaddesden Ward Board agreed that the 3 priorities are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Football parking • Speeding • Crossing on Nottingham Rd by St Marys Retail Park <p>A survey has been completed on Highfield Lane in respect of the problems with football parking. The report will hopefully be completed within the next month.</p> <p>John pointed out that football parking is a problem in other areas of Chaddesden, one of the major concerns being Nottingham Rd from Aldi to Raynesway. He asked if it would be possible to extend the double yellow lines.</p> | <p>Explore alternative funding streams for work to Meadow Lane footbridge</p> <p>Christine to look into the lighting on Derby Rd</p> <p>Christine to enquire re drainage on Morley Rd</p> |

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| | <p>The estimated cost to make the Meadow Lane footbridge accessible to disability scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs is £300,000. This would be a major capital expenditure. Alternative funding streams will be explored.</p> <p>Anne expressed concern that the new lighting on Derby Rd junction Eden Rd appears to be of an inferior quality. Christine will look into the matter.</p> <p>Concern was expressed about the lack of lighting on the Meadow Lane footpath. This was noted by Christine. Christine will also make enquiries as to whether the drainage on Morley Rd will be improved.</p> | |
