Taxi Licensing Fees and Charges 2022/23

Purpose

- 1.1 The report provides information on the proposed licence fees and charges for driver, vehicle and operator licences and other charges for 2022/23.

Recommendation(s)

- 2.1 To approve, subject to the consideration of representations, the proposed licence fees and charges for driver, vehicle and operator licences and other charges for 2022/23 as set out at Appendix 1.
- 2.2 To request the Service Director of Public Protection and Streetpride to advertise the proposed fees and charges.
- 2.3 To delegate to the Service Director of Public Protection and Streetpride following consultation with the Chair, to consider any representations received within the required period and to take appropriate action if required to address such representations.
- 2.4 To approve the new licence fees and charges to become effective from 1 April 2022, subject to there not being any representations received during the required period, or where any such representations have been considered.

Reason(s)

- 3.1 The hackney carriage and private hire licensing fees and charges are reviewed regularly to ensure the total costs incurred in providing the services are recovered.
- 3.2 Certain licence fees and charges must be advertised, and any objections or representations received must be considered by the Council.

Supporting information

- 4.1 Separate accounts must be kept for each type of licence issued; namely those for hackney carriage drivers, hackney carriage vehicles, private hire drivers, private hire vehicles and private hire operators.

- 4.2 The proposed licence fees and charges for driver, vehicle and operator licences and other charges for 2022/23 are set out in Appendix 1. They remain the same as the fees and charges that were approved for the 2021/22 period.

Public/stakeholder engagement

- 5.1 The Council is required to publish in a local newspaper the proposals for changes to the level of driver, vehicle and operator fees. Any objections or representations must be lodged within 28 days from the date of the publication and considered by the Council.
- 5.2 Where a representation is made and not withdrawn, the Council must consider it. In the event of this occurring, any matters that may arise can be considered at the next scheduled meeting of the Licensing Committee.

Other options

- 6.1 None. Fees and charges need to be set at a level to recover the total costs incurred in providing the service.

Financial and value for money issues

- 7.1 The proposed fees and charges have been set at a level to recover the full cost of providing the current taxi licensing service.
- 7.2 Any mid-year changes to the administrative process that impact on costs will be contained within existing budgets.

Legal implications

- 8.1 Sections 53 and 70 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 (“the Act”) allow the Council to charge fees for the grant of licences in respect of hackney carriage and private hire drivers, vehicles and operators. The legislation and relevant case law specify the elements that can be included in the cost of the licence fee.
- 8.2 In accordance with the requirements set out in section 70(3)(b) of the Act, before certain new fees and charges are introduced, the Council is required to publish them in a local newspaper. Any representations must be lodged within 28 days from the date of the publication.
