06/07 Report on Fair Shares Protocol (In Year fair Access) Managed Moves and Hard to Place 2006-07

The Forum considered a report from the Corporate Director for Children and Young People setting out details of the Fair Shares Partnership Agreement, which had been approved by Secondary Heads and the Forum in 2004. Sue Bradley, Chair of the Managed Moves/Hard to Place panel presented the report. The initial agreement established a protocol for arranging a Managed Move for a pupil between secondary schools as an early intervention to avoid permanent exclusion. The Managed Moves protocol has been operated for three years. A summary of the results was given in the report appendices.

Roger Shipton, Merrill College commended Sue and her team on the results of the work.

The Chair asked if there had been any exclusions in the Primary Sector. Sue responded that there had been five for the year 2006/07.

Paul Clarke, Cavendish Close Junior School asked why some schools had not taken any managed moves. Sue said that the placements depended on the needs of the individual pupil and what a school could offer. Cathy Ford, added that during the panel meetings schools volunteer to take pupils according to their particular aptitude.

The Chair thanked Sue for presenting a comprehensive report.
