Guiding Principals

- Purpose is to alleviate short-term pressures on local services occurring as a result of inward migration.
- Intention is not to be overly prescriptive. Some ways in which it
- Consistent with and supports existing strategies and plans

Migration Impact Fund

- Supports cohesion
- Reduces burdens on local services
- Promotes efficient use of public services

Migration Impact Fund

- Could be used to: -
 - Reduce the burden of interpreting costs, e.g. recruitment of Community Support Officers from migrant communities, or providing a pool of interpreters across local services.

Migration Impact Fund

- Prevent overcrowding in housing used by migrants.
- Provide extra support teachers and children's services in areas where migration has led to a high turnover of pupils in schools.
- Support projects to improve community safety
