- Competing demands for the health team eg: IHAs and Adoption work
- UASC and former UASC additional health needs
- Transition for care experienced young people
- Was not brought (work on-going)

- Collaboration continues to remain stronger than ever between partner agencies
- Embedding of Enhanced Case Management Meetings and impact for children / young people
- Sleep Practitioner within the team
- Impact for children and young people making a difference.
- Childrens stories brought to life



## **Priorities for 2022/23**

- Deliver further health promotion sessions
- Resume foster carer sessions face to face
- Continue working closely with the Derbyshire CIC team to embed a Joined-up Care Derbyshire Approach
- Build relationships with the leaving care team to improve support around transition
- Deliver quarterly action learning sets for all CIC Nurses in collaboration with the Designated Nurse for Looked after Children
- Roll out the training resource for foster carers and residential children care workers to use when supporting children and young people with sexual health.
- Newly appointed Doctor for Adoption
- Continue to provide opportunities for students
