SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 At its meeting on 11 June 2007 the Planning and Transportation Commission considered a number of possible work plan options and selected highway maintenance as the subject of a review of 2007/08.
- 2.2 Work on the review started in December 2007. Questionnaires were sent to 475 local people to gauge their opinions of the maintenance programme. In addition questionnaires were sent to 16 comparable Unitary Authorities to establish how they funded their maintenance programmes.
- 2.3 The report provided to the Commission is a first working draft. An attempt will be made to include amendments suggested by the Chair at the pre-meeting and if this is possible a revised draft report will be circulated to members prior to the Commission meeting on 17 March. The first draft topic contained in Appendix 2 does however contain clear details of the research carried out and the results of that research.
- 2.4 The Commission are asked to consider the report and to decide what recommendations they wish to make to the Council Cabinet Member.
