<p>Please describe briefly the nature of the proposed variation (Please see guidance note 2)</p> <p>Spondon Liberal Club is a members club situated in a central location within the village. COVID 19 has forced some major changes to how the business operates. Since April 2021 the club has operated a table service to its members in the newly created beer garden.</p> <p>We currently provide table service to our customers in the beer garden. This service means our staff are up and down the stairs with trays of drinks. To minimise risk of accidents on the stairs, the club would like to provide a serving point from the beer garden. Should another lockdown be incurred the club would be able to operate without opening the full facilities of the club.</p> <p>The long-term vision is to build a brick out-building which would occupy the same space to the current smoking shed and provide a permanent garden room in the beer garden. However to achieve this in a phased approach the club has purchased a mobile trailer and wants to serve alcohol from this trailer.</p>
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Over time, the club intends to submit planning permission to erect a permanent building to provide the service for many years to come. The club also intends to use the catering trailer to serve some form of food in the future.

This variation to the club licence is to apply to the area known as the beer garden and car park only. No variation is required to activities taking place within the club.

Detailed drawings and designs have not been completed for the beer garden therefore the club is applying to licence the complete outside space. The size of the beer garden would fall within the less than 500 people categories.

Enclosing the beer garden with planters and forced all delivery drivers to park vehicles at the club car park entrance which has resulted in less congestion towards the chapel street mini roundabout.

All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a supervising adult or guardian. Perimeter fence has been erected to completely secure the public area and protect children from the public highway.

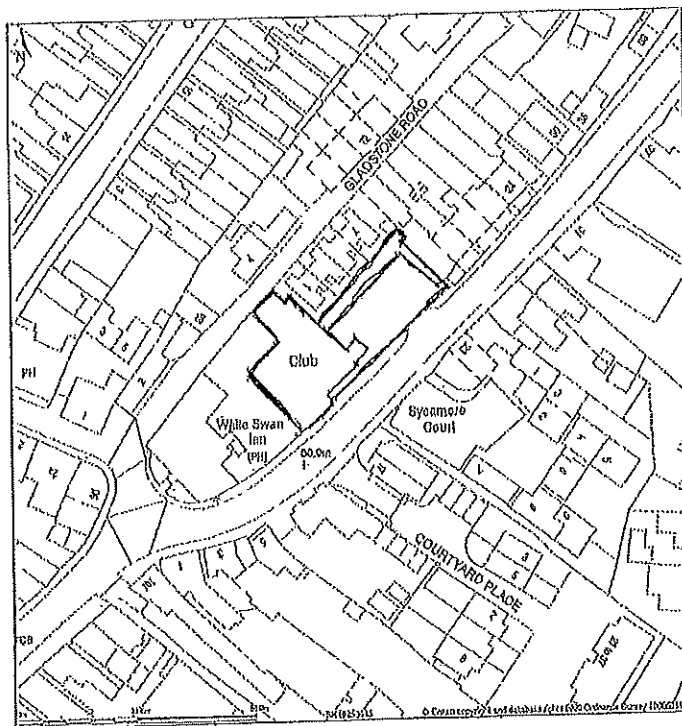

The Licensing Team,

I am writing to make a representation to oppose the application made by Spondon Liberal Club to have an outside Trailer to serve alcohol and also their application to extend their opening hours on Fridays and Saturdays to 11.59PM.

I have lived at my Bungalow for 12 years in November and never had a problem with noise from the Club until April 2021. When I moved here the new Beer Garden was the Clubs Tarmaced Car Park. The noise started in April 2021 from The Marquee which was erected in 2020. The noise was first from in my opinion a very loud Radio on seven days a week and then when Live Music

was aloud Live Bands playing and still
do on most Saturdays and Sundays. I
have ^{recorded by operator 6 20/6/21 05:56} phoned the Club on many occasions
and asked them politely to reduce the
noise but the answer as always been we
do not need to as we have a Music
License. The noise was so loud on two
occasions that after phoning and asking
for the noise to be reduced and the answer
being the same I phoned the Police Call
Centre. I have two Incident Numbers

Sunday 30th May 2021 857

Monday 31st May 2021 733

both call handlers I spoke to said they
could hear the noise over the telephone
and the one I spoke to on the Monday
said he would send a message to the
Licensing Team because the noise was
unacceptable. I have also spoken to
Sarah Page at Environmental Health and
she offered to have a noise monitor installed
for me but I have yet to decide if I

want one. The Marquee and outside drinks
Trailer are directly opposite my Bedroom
windows which is at most only 60 yards
away from the Beer Garden. The Club
has residential properties on three sides
of it being at the back, one side and
directly opposite and for them to be open
until 11.59pm on Fridays and Saturdays
seem to me to be unacceptable.

The Liberal Club states that it has
concerns for staff safety on the stairs
but the club has been trading for well
over 50 years and if customers do not wish
to use the Marquee or the Stairs there is
another entrance to the Club on Gladstone
Road if they use that it is on the same
level as the Bar and lounge.

I have enclosed an advertisement which
was in the local Spendon C&C Magazine
where they are advertising the Club events for
August and September and also offering the
Marquee for Private Functions again will

if the morquee is used for more functions
this I think will mean more music. I
have ^{scanned by operator 6 24/6/73 09/14} never had and still do not have
any noise from The Club members it has
always been from the music noise. Music
is on in the morquee in some forms
sometimes seven days a week and when the
Football and Tennis was on they had a
very large Television in there. I do not
know but do the staff members monitor
the noise!

ANNEX 1 – MANDATORY CONDITIONS

DOOR SUPERVISION

Each individual required to be at the premises to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industries Authority.

SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL

1. The supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises can only be made at a time when the premises are open for supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
2. Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
3. Any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

MANDATORY CONDITION IMPLEMENTED ON 28 MAY 2014.

1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 —
(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula — $P = D + (D \times V)$
Where — P is the permitted price,

- (ii) D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

(c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—

- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994

3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

MANDATORY CONDITIONS IMPLEMENTED 1 OCTOBER 2014

1. (1). The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises."
- (2) An irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially



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similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises –

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to –

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective.

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective.;

(d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner).

(e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

3. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The Designated Premises Supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either

(a) holographic mark or

(b) an ultraviolet feature

4. The responsible person must ensure that –

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures –



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- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

EXHIBITION OF FILMS

- 1 No film shall be exhibited unless:
 - a. it has received a "U", "PG", "12A", "15", or "18" certificate of the British Board of Film Classification; or
 - b. it is a current newsreel, which has not been submitted to the British Board of Film Classification.
- 2 "18" Films
No person apparently under the age of eighteen years shall be admitted to any exhibition at which there is to be shown any film which has received an "18" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
- 3 "15" Films
No person apparently under the age of fifteen years shall be admitted to any exhibition at which there is to be shown any film which has received an "15" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
- 4 "12A" Films
No person apparently under the age of twelve years shall be admitted to any exhibition unless accompanied by an adult at which there is to be shown any film, which has received a "12A" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.
- 5 "PG" Films
Some scenes contained at which there is to be shown any film, which has received a "PG" certificate from the British Board of Film Classification, may be unsuitable for young children.
- 6 "U" Films



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Films suitable for all is any film, which has received a "U", certificate from the British Board of Film Classification.

- 7 Permission of Licensing Authority
Notwithstanding the above, a film may be exhibited, or persons, or any class of person, may be admitted thereto if the permission of the licensing authority is first obtained and any conditions of such permission are complied with.

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

1. Any CCTV system must be maintained in good working order and be operated when the premises is open to the public. Recordings must be shown to an Authorised Officer or Police Officer if requested.
2. Drinks purchased from the bar must only be served in toughened glass.
3. You must make adequate arrangements to enable the safe evacuation of disabled people in the event of an emergency. You must ensure that sufficient notice is given to make people aware of these arrangements.
4. Fire safety signs must be adequately illuminated.
5. You must not alter any emergency lighting.
6. You must ensure emergency lighting batteries are fully charged before the admission of the public, members or guests.
7. In the event of the failure of normal lighting, you must ensure that arrangements are in place to ensure that the public, members or guests leave the premises within twenty minutes if the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of one hour or within one hour if the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of three hours.
8. The use of special effects will be limited to that brought to the premises by and used by visiting artistes. This will be arranged so as to minimise any risk to the safety of the public, performers and staff.



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9. Noise from the Premises must not unreasonably disturb other people.
10. You must display prominent, clear and legible notices at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
11. Refuse, such as bottles, shall not be placed into receptacles outside the premises between 23:00 hours and 07:00 in order to minimise the disturbance to nearby properties.
12. Noxious smells from the premises must not cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
13. Artificial lighting on the premises must not cause a nuisance to nearby properties, unless it is considered necessary by the Derbyshire Constabulary for the prevention of crime and disorder.
14. Persons under the age of 18 years are permitted in the club if accompanied by a responsible member.
15. You must apply a policy requiring the production of proof of age from any person appearing to those selling or supplying alcohol to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to buy alcohol.
16. Persons under the age of 18 years will not be permitted access to entertainment of an adult nature.
