# 42/06 Child Protection Issues in Places of Worship

Members received a presentation from Mark Sobey, Derby Safeguarding Children's Board Policy Officer, on the role of the Safeguarding Children's Board in Derby and how increasing partnership working would ensure the safety of Children in the City. SACRE discussed the need for a policy to protect children in places of worship. Mark commented that most groups would have their own policy, producing a policy for everyone to sign up to would help those groups that did not have a policy in place and to ensure that those that did were up to date. Mark advised that training would be provided to groups although it was difficult to ensure they continued with training.

# Resolved to look at the Child Protection issues in Places of Worship document at the next meeting and to discuss a policy for Derby.
