The Committee received an update on the City Centre Grant Schemes from Dr Valeria Passetti the Grant Officer.

There have been two grant schemes running within the city centre. These have provided for the repairs and reinstatements of shop fronts and have been offered to 64 properties. The Committee received a visual presentation showing some of the schemes that have been completed and those that are underway or will be completed over the next year.

39/11 George Rennie Award and Commendations

The Committee discussed the nominations for this years George Rennie Award:

- The Shopfront renovations to the Strand (To be treated as a group)
- The Greyhound Public House, Friar Gate
- · Bennetts. Iron Gate.

Members agreed that The Greyhound Public House, Friargate, will receive this years George Rennie Award. This was due to the care and detail devoted to its restoration in accordance to its historic form. It was also agreed that Bennetts, Iron Gate, will receive a Commendation for the restoration of its traditional left-hand shop front to its 1930's brass shop fronted form.

Members agreed the arrangements for the award ceremony. It will take place before the Advisory Committee meeting on Thursday 24 November 2011. The venue will be the Oak Room in Royal Oak House and the ceremony will begin at 4.00pm. The Mayor will be available to attend. At the conclusion of the ceremony the members will make their way back to Saxon House for 5.15pm.

The Committee recommended refusal. There is no heritage assessment submitted with the application. The Committee highlighted that the building has some merit as the earliest motor garage within the city centre and has an ornate cast canopy covering, what was, the former area of the petrol pumps. There is also no detail of

what is proposed in the area. The proposal currently does not preserve or enhance the character of the conservation area.

Proposal: Change of use of St Helens House and the Pearson Building from

Educational Buildings (Use Class D1) to offices/conference facilities (Use Classes B1 and D1) with internal alterations, provision of glazed link, erection of boundary wall, demolition of existing link, extensions

and boundary wall.

The Committee recommended refusal on the grounds that the screen and subdivisions of the two major rooms on the ground floor would damage their appearance and historic integrity.

The Committee raised no objection, subject to the garage door having a vertically wooden panelled appearance when closed.

Proposal: Re-positioning of door and window on front elevation

The Committee raised no objection, subject to the control of materials.

41/11 The National Planning Policy Framework

The Committee received an Officer presentation on the government's proposed National Planning Policy Framework in relation to its possible impact upon the historic environment.

The policy is under consultation at the moment and this will end in October 2011. A joint council response is currently being put together.

42/11 Derby City Greenway (Phase 2 works)

The Committee considered the planned Phase 2 works for the Derby City Greenway Project. The scheme involves a number of environmental improvement projects along the river corridor between Handyside's Bridge and St Mary's Bridge.

The Committee raised no objection to existing paths being widened. The Committee raised no objection to tarmac being used where paths have already been surfaced with tarmac. The Committee recommended that tarmac not be used for the surfacing of any new paths (that were rural in character) and that an alternative be found (such as resin bound gravel or loose chip stones). The Committee objected to the design of the railings already installed under St Mary's Bridge.
