09/14 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meetings held on 17 July 2014 were agreed as acorrectrecord and signed by the Chair subject to the removal of CouncillorRobertsfrom the attendance list and the addition of Councillor Wright.

10/14 Taxi Licensing Administration and Compliance Activities – Quarter 1 (2014/15)

The Committee considered a report from the Strategic Director of Neighbourhoods on the activities the taxi licensing service had undertaken during quarter 1 of the 2014/15 financial year.

Members were disappointed to understand that it was becoming increasingly difficult to carry out multi agency enforcement work with the resources available within the relevant agencies. It was noted that correspondence had been received from Derbyshire Constabulary stating that should any future enforcement work be required there would be a charge for this. The Committee stated that enforcement work was an important part of partnership working and the Local Authority during parts of this required Police assistance to meet certain regulations. Members felt that further explanation should be sought from Derbyshire Constabulary and requested that officers write to the Superintendent Gary Parkin at Derby Constabulary and the Police Commissioner to seek an explanation as to the change proposed. The Committee also requested that an invitation be extended to Gary Parkin for him to attend the next meeting of the Committee to allow him to share this information with them.

The Committee were provided with the latest details of the outstanding drivers that had not yet completed the NVQ. It was noted that the numbers outstanding were still high but that procedures were in place to deal with any licensed drivers should they continue to drive after the cut off date.
