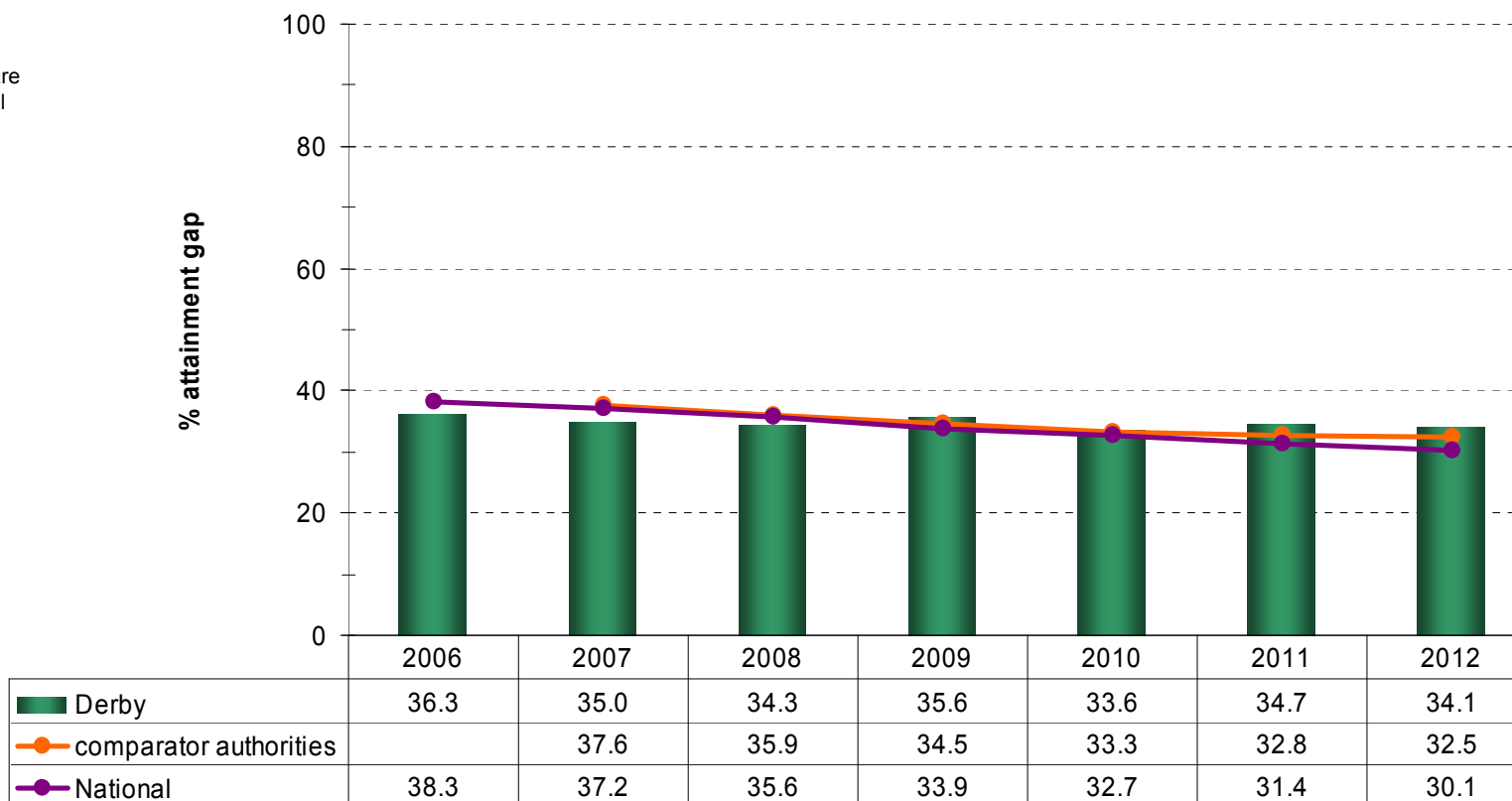

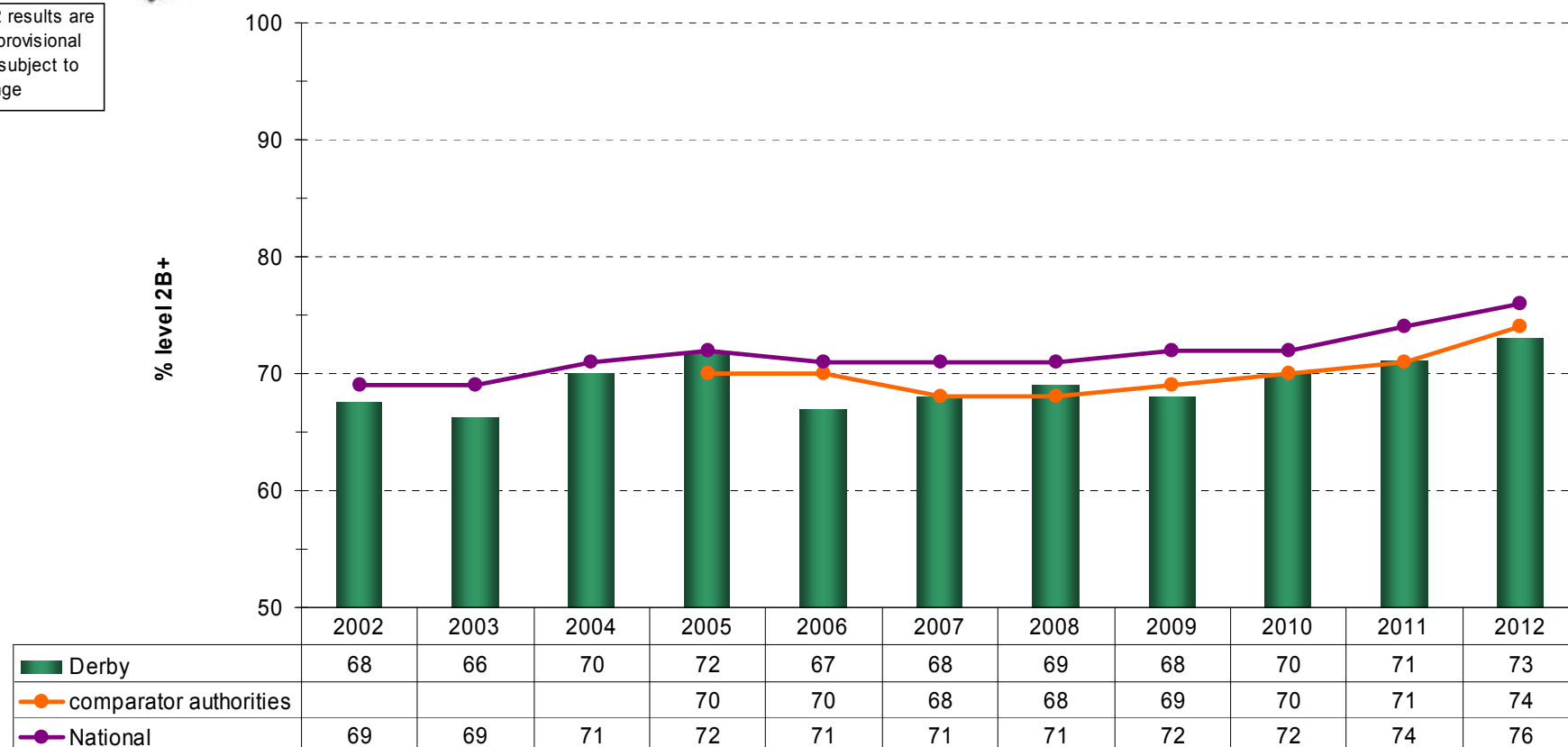

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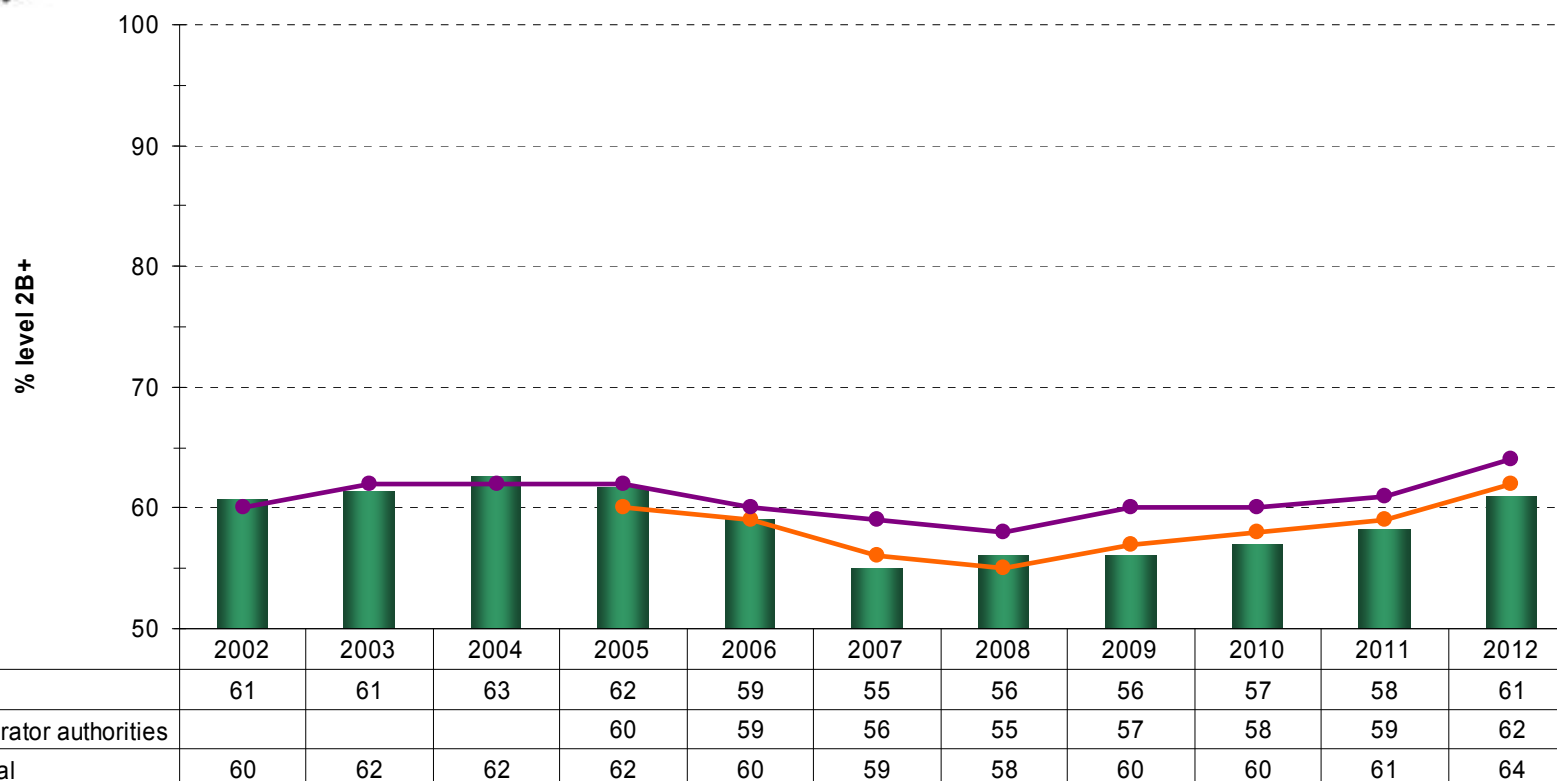
Key Stage 1 reading: level 2B+

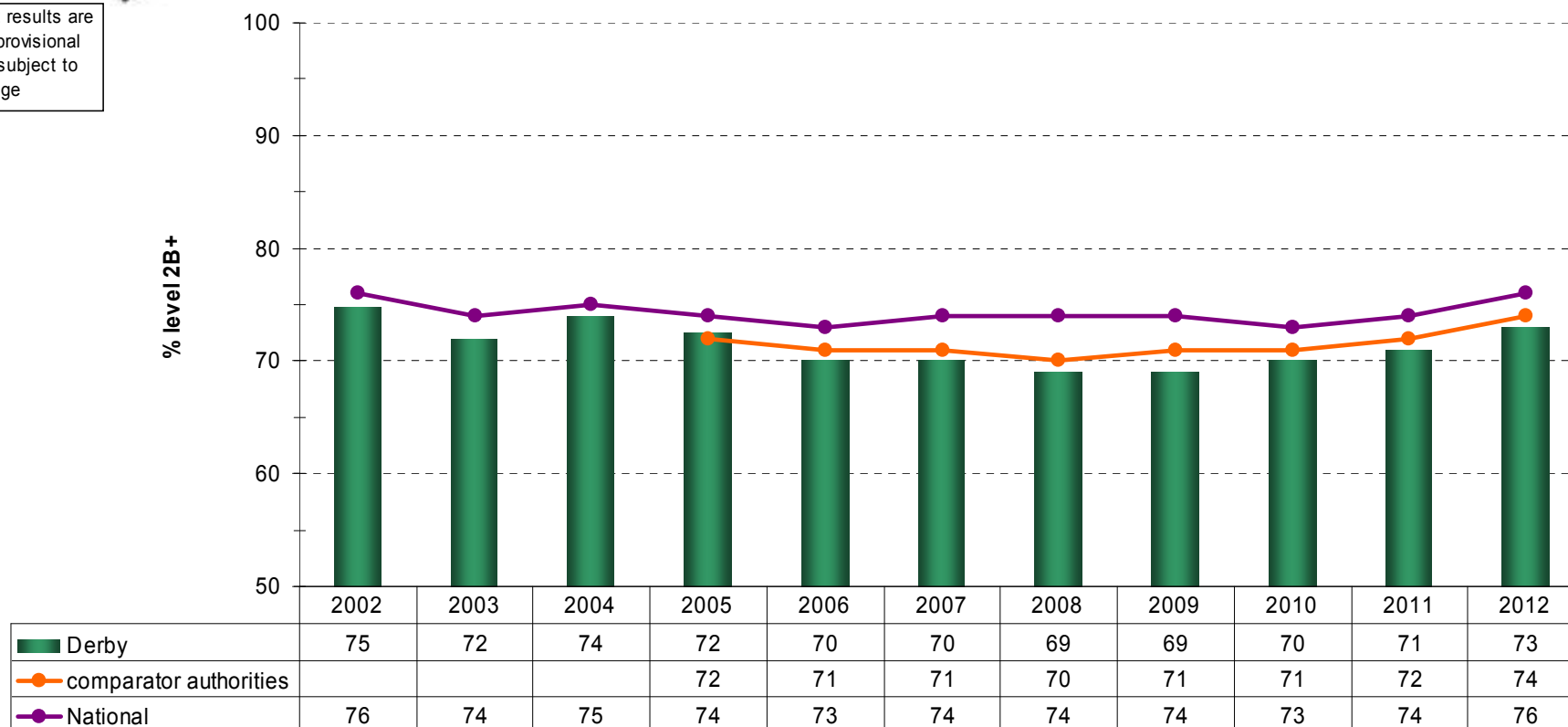
Key Stage 1 writing: level 2B+

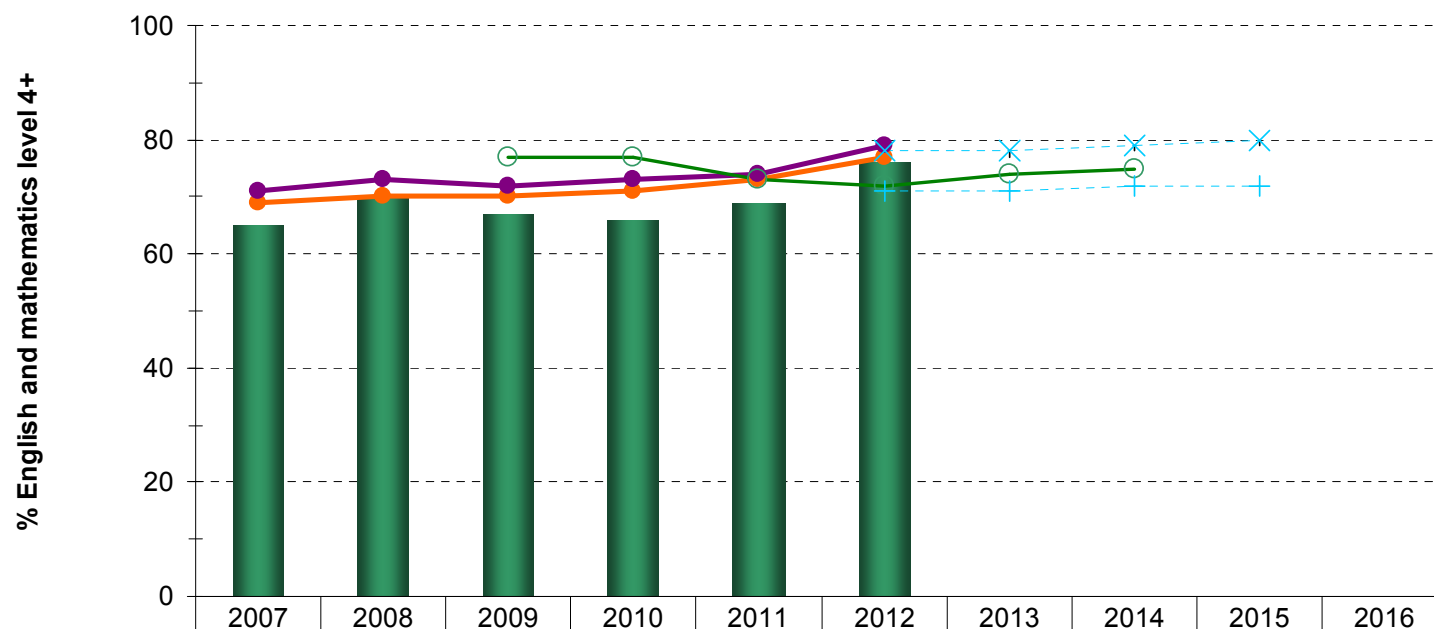

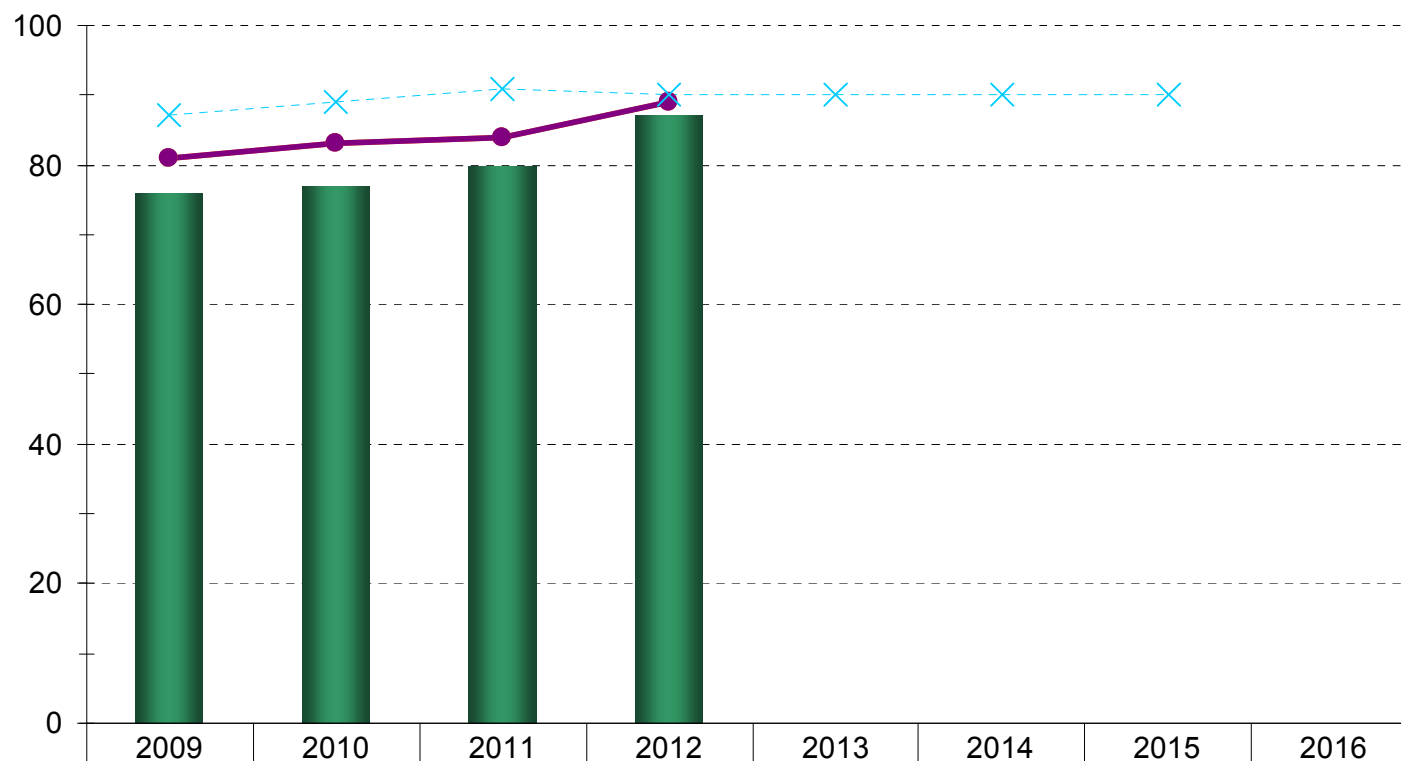
Only 5 schools and one academy remain below 60% threshold compared to 18 in 2011

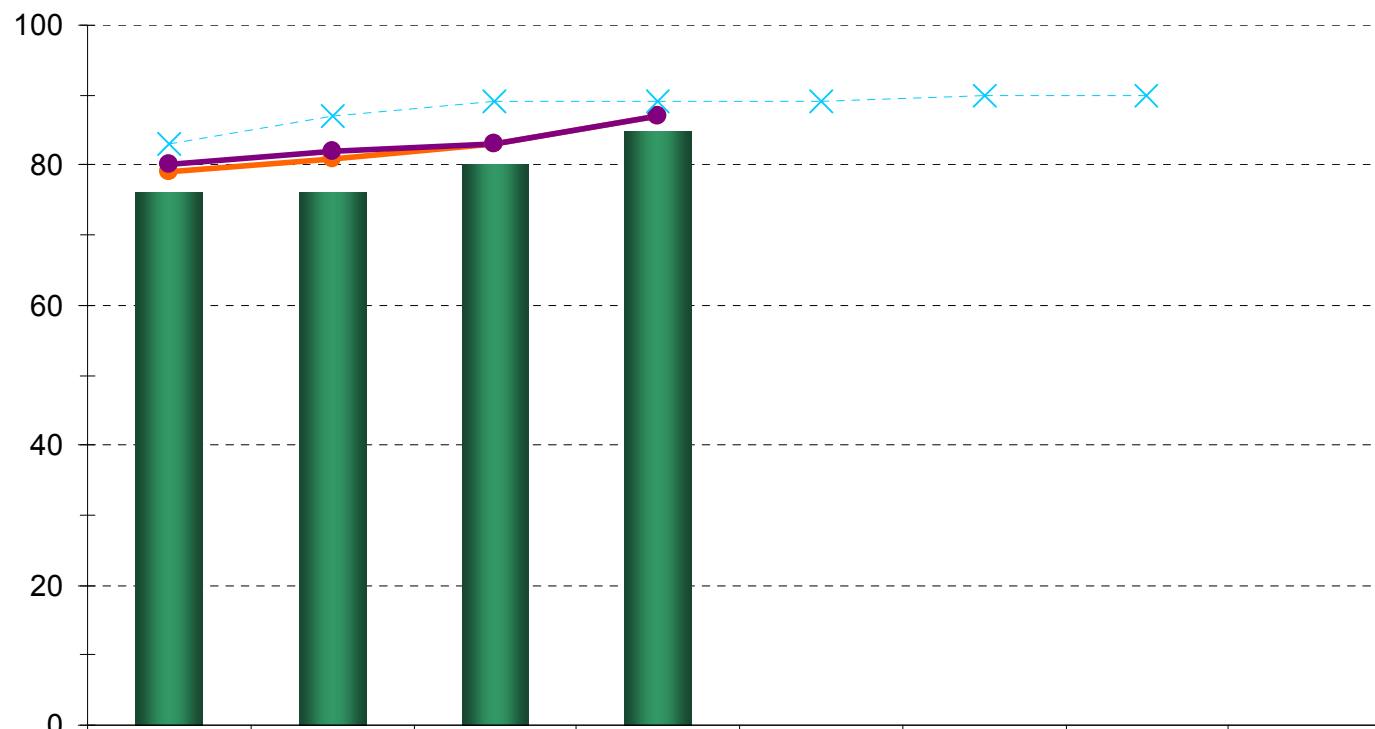

FSM gap has narrowed for reading and maths at L2B+

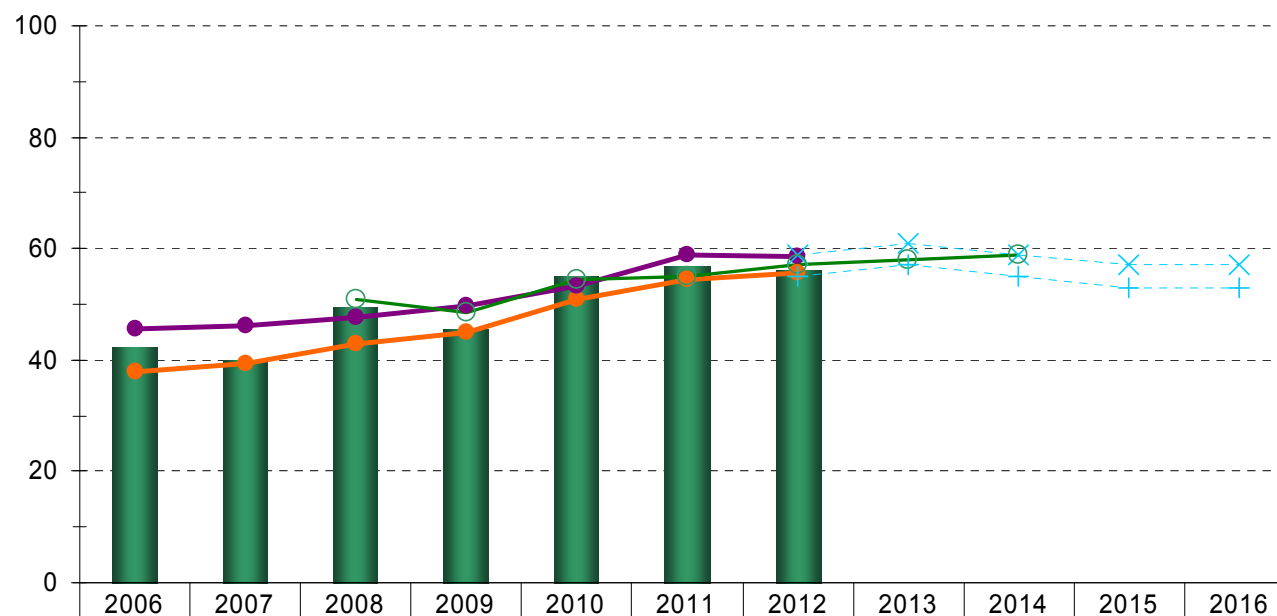
KS2
