45/04 Area Panel Budget Proposals 2004/05

A report of the Assistant Director - Community Policy was considered which set out details of four applications for funding which had been received.

It was reported that the first application was from the Chaddesden Park Allotment Association. They were seeking a grant of £3,506 towards security fencing for the allotment site.

The second application was from Nottingham Road and District Allotments Association Limited. They were seeking a grant of £875 towards a potting shed for Meadow Farm School allotments.

The third application was from Derby and Sandiacre Canal Society. They were seeking £1,800 towards canal interpretation panels in Spondon.

The fourth application was from Spondon Community Association. They were seeking £2,500 towards Spondon in Bloom 2005.

Options considered

The Panel assessed each application for funding against the agreed criteria and priorities.

Decision

- To award a grant of £3,506 to the Chaddesden Park Allotment Association towards security fencing for the allotment site.
- To award a grant of £875 to Nottingham Road and District Allotments Association Limited towards a potting shed for Meadow Farm School allotments.
- To award a grant of £1,800 to Derby and Sandiacre Canal Society towards canal interpretation panels in Spondon.
- To award a grant of £2,500 to Spondon Community Association towards Spondon in Bloom 2005.

Reasons

- the applications provided evidence of needs, both in terms of enabling residents to participate in activities within their community and providing a service in response to the needs of local residents and which would provide a benefit to all residents.
