Parking on Nightingale Road

SUMMARY

- 1.1 A previous report on this matter was considered on the 4 April 2007 which concluded that amendments should not be pursued to waiting restrictions on Nightingale Road.
- 1.2 The Cabinet Member for Planning, Highways and Transport has requested that this matter again be reviewed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That amendments to waiting restrictions on Nightingale Road should not be pursued at this moment for the reasons set out in previous reports.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The Council, as Highway Authority, has to take full account of the needs of all highway users. The primary purpose of any highway is to facilitate the passage of people and goods and this must take precedence over the desire to park.
- 3.2 Emergency Services have commented that they continue to use Nightingale Road as an emergency response route and they would not support any revocation in waiting restrictions at this time.
