# Annual Governance Statement to accompany the Statement of Accounts 2015/2016

#### SUMMARY

- 1.1 An Annual Governance Statement is required to support the Statement of Accounts 2015/2016.
- 1.2 Audit & Accounts Committee will be updated by the Interim Director of Finance at the meeting on the progress of the audit of the 2015/2016 Statement of Accounts.
- 1.3 It is proposed that given the passage of time, the Committee accepts the Interim Annual Governance presented to the meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017, as the Annual Governance Statement for the period 2015/2016. It is however acknowledged that this same document also addresses a number of issues which have arisen during the 2016/2017 period.

#### RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To accept the Interim Annual Governance Statement presented to the Audit & Accounts Committee on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017, as the Annual Governance Statement for the year 2015/2016.
- 2.2 To note that the said Annual Governance Statement also addresses a number of issues which have arisen during the 2016/2017 period given the passage of time and the delays in presenting the 2015/2016 Statement of Accounts.

#### **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION**

3.1 An Annual Governance is required to support the Council's Statement of Accounts.

4.1 Given the delays with the preparation of the 2015/2016 Statement of Accounts, the Audit & Accounts Committee has received successive updates to the Annual Governance Statement on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2016, and 30<sup>th</sup> November 2016 and 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

- 4.2 Given the passage of time, it is considered that it is no longer possible to update the Annual Governance Statement relating to 2015/2016.
- 4.3 The Interim Annual Governance Statement has previously been presented with comprehensive supporting material to the Audit & Accounts Committee meetings on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2016, 30<sup>th</sup> November 201, and 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017.
- 4.4 This document does contain significant material which relates to the year 2016/2017, and an updating Annual Governance Statement will be presented to a future meeting of the Audit & Accounts Committee alongside the accounts for 2016/2017.
