14/15 Oakwood Local Transport Plan (LTP) Priorities 2016/17

The Ward Committee agreed the LTP priorities would be:

Priority 1: Morley Road bus stops – to upgrade up to six bus stops on Morley Road to include the inbound and outbound stops at three locations. Proposed upgrade to include access kerbs, clearway marking and dropped crossings to allow access to the bus stop, with the extension of the hard standing with a safety rail at the rear as required. Derbyshire County Council have a made a commitment to contribute to the cost.
