

Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Derby North, Derby South and the city parts of the Mid Derbyshire Parliamentary Constituencies

Consultation Document

July 2011

Background

Section 16 of the Electoral Administration Act 2006 introduced a number of changes to the Representation of the People Act 1983 in respect of the way reviews of polling districts and polling places must be carried out.

The most important thing to note is that by 31 December 2011, every relevant authority must have undertaken and completed a review of all of the polling districts and polling places in its area. This consultation document has been produced as part of Derby's review.

The legalisation requires that reviews are carried out based on Parliamentary Constituencies. For Derby City this includes the Derby North and Derby South Parliamentary Constituencies and the part of the Mid Derbyshire Constituency falling within the city boundary. For those areas outside of the City which fall within the Mid Derbyshire Parliamentary Constituency, Amber Valley and Erewash Borough Council's will be carrying out their own separate reviews.

Definitions

a) Polling Districts

A polling district is a geographical sub-division of an electoral area, such as a parliamentary constituency or a ward.

As the relevant authority, the Council is responsible for designating polling districts, and must therefore seek to ensure that all electors in the parliamentary constituency have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances

b) Polling Places

There is no legal definition of what a polling place is. However in Derby a polling place is a geographical location in which a polling station is situated. Although it is usual to have one polling station in one polling place, there are situations where several polling stations are located in one polling place. The polling place for a polling district must be within the area of the district unless special circumstances make it desirable to designate an area either wholly or partly outside of the polling district.

As the relevant authority, the Council is responsible for determining polling places, and must therefore make sure that the polling places are accessible to all electors and must take into account the accessibility needs of disabled people.

c) Polling Stations

A polling station is the actual area in which the process of voting takes place and must be located in the polling place designated for the particular polling district. The polling station may consist of a whole room or in certain circumstances a designated area within a room or building.

The (Acting) Returning Officer for the particular election is responsible for providing a sufficient number of polling stations and allotting electors to those polling stations. Polling

stations must be located within the polling places designated by the council, and these are within the scope of the review.

The publication of this consultation document represents the first stage of the review. The existing schedule of polling districts and polling places is included in Appendix A. This appendix also provides a breakdown of the number of electors allocated to each polling district that are eligible to vote at the polling station. A set of maps illustrating where the boundaries of the polling districts are located will be available to view on the council's website at www.derby.gov.uk/elections Copies of the maps will also be available to view at Roman House Reception.

As part of this first stage you are invited to comment on the existing scheme, and if you feel it appropriate you may suggest changes to polling district boundaries or alternative proposals for polling places. It would help us if you could also give reasons for changes you have suggested.

All representations will be published on the Council's website as soon as possible after receipt, even if you have already commented on the proposals; you may make further submissions in response to views and comments you see on the website.

What happens next?

On Friday 23 September 2011 the views of the Returning Officer on both the scheme and any representations made will be published. You will then have until Friday 28 October 2011 to comment on their submissions. On 23 November Full Council will consider all the issues raised and publish its final scheme, according to which the 2012 electoral register will be published on 1 December 2011.
